● THE CARROLL BENGE MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE

This scholarship is provided from a legacy to the School by Mrs Carroll Benge, former Principal of Craighead Diocesan School. The scholarship is to enable a student to continue with her music studies, while a Boarder at Craighead.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDING

The scholarship is held for one year only. Accounts for up to \$500 may be forwarded to the School for payment in the year for which the scholarship is given. The funds may be used for music tuition fees, music books or music examination entry fees.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be a Boarder in Year 7 to Year 12 and must be intending to return to Craighead in the year in which the scholarship will be received.
- The Scholarship will cease if the recipient ceases to be a Boarder in the year of the award.
- The award is made based on a performance at the Music Cup held each year at Craighead. The adjudicator is to consider performance primarily and potential as a secondary factor.
- A student may not be re-awarded this scholarship.

SELECTION

The decision to award the scholarship is at the discretion of the Principal and will be made by the Adjudicator in consultation with the Teacher in Charge of Music. The recipient will be announced on the evening of the Music Cup and included in the Prizegiving at the end of the Year.

APPLICATIONS – should be made on the enclosed form to the Teacher in Charge of Music, **by the 23 October 2015**, the week before the date of the Music Cup in Term 4.
