- Maryann Ogden Scholarship

**The Maryann Ogden Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to senior students travelling overseas to enhance their second language studies.**

### **Definition**

Second Language means a language other than English

The Scholarship is awarded to individual students, not to students travelling as part of a Craighead School group.

### **Criteria**

Students eligible to be awarded this Scholarship will:

- be studying a second language for NCEA at Craighead Diocesan School
- have a proven commitment to language study
- be required to demonstrate how they will benefit from the experience
- be continuing their second language studies on their return to School

### **Process**

The Scholarship will be advertised annually via the School Newsletter and School Website.

The application must be submitted on the appropriate application form. Application forms will be available from the School Office.

Applications must be given to the Head of Languages by 13 November 2015.

The students' school reports will be made available by the School to the selection panel.

Applications will be assessed by a selection made up of the Chair of the Board of Proprietors, the Head of Languages and the Principal. The panel's decision will be final and in its sole judgement.

It is envisaged that the Maryann Ogden Scholarship will be awarded annually in Term Four and announced at the end-of-year Prizegiving.

A cheque will be made payable to the successful student when confirmation of her flight bookings has been received by the School. Where a student does not participate in the proposed trip the money will be returned to the Board of Proprietors and reinvested with the fund.
